

## HONORS COLLEGE APPLICATION

In reviewing applications, the Honors College places special emphasis on the written material submitted. The strength of the high school curriculum, GPA and standardized test scores are also very important. Freshmen who wish to apply to the Honors College should have a high school GPA of 3.5 or better and good standardized test scores. Successful applicants for Fall 2018 had an average of 1400 on the SAT and an average of over 30 on the ACT. Transfers who wish to apply to the Honors College should have a strong GPA (above a 3.5) and typically should have been enrolled in an honors program at their previous institution. Established students who wish to apply to the Honors College should have a strong GPA (above a 3.5) at UMBC.
